

ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN ATTORNEYS FOUNDATION 2024 SCHOLARSHIP AND FELLOWSHIP APPLICATIONS

The **ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN ATTORNEYS** ("AWA") is currently seeking qualified applicants for AWA Foundation ("AWAF") scholarships and fellowships to be awarded to deserving second and third year female-identifying law students in Houston, Texas. The applications are attached.

SCHOLARSHIPS

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The AWAF Scholarships are intended to:

<u>Recognize</u> law students who have demonstrated a commitment to excellence and an aptitude for leadership and philanthropy;

Promote excellence in legal studies by providing assistance to deserving students; and

<u>Advance</u> the purposes of the AWA and the AWAF, which include promoting the welfare and interests of women lawyers, maintaining the honor and integrity of the profession of law, encouraging philanthropy by women lawyers, and informing and educating women lawyers on matters pertaining to their professional interests and status.

AWARDS GIVEN: At least one scholarship of \$2,500 to a current second-year student and at least one scholarship of \$3,500 to a current third-year student will be awarded to deserving women studying at each of the three Houston area law schools (University of Houston, South Texas College of Law Houston, and Thurgood Marshall School of Law). The scholarship recipients will also receive a professional head shot and a membership in the AWA for one year and will be honored at the 11th Annual Premier Women in Law Luncheon on April 11, 2024.

ELIGIBILITY: Any second-year or third-year female-identifying law student currently enrolled at a law school in Houston, Texas who has earned at least 30 credit hours is eligible to apply.

CRITERIA: Scholarships will be awarded to applicants who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership and philanthropic potential, a strong commitment to the profession, and/or the ability to overcome difficult obstacles. Involvement in programs that highlight advancement or support of women in the legal profession and in the community and participation in community outreach programs will also be considered. Financial need will also be considered.

FELLOWSHIPS (3L APPLICANTS ONLY)

FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM: This year, the AWAF Pro Bono Fellowship Program will partner with <u>Houston Volunteer Lawyers</u> ("HVL") and <u>Tahirih Justice Center</u> ("Tahirih") to select at least one third-year fellowship applicant who will serve the community as a Fellow for one year beginning on or after September 1, 2024 (the "Fellowship Start Date"). The AWAF will fund all or part of the salary of each selected Fellow for the one year Fellowship Program.

<u>At HVL</u>, the Fellow will assist with legal matters involving family law, guardianship, estate planning, landlord/tenant disputes, tax disputes with the IRS, homeownership, consumer law, and bankruptcy.

<u>At Tahirih</u>, the Fellow will work on matters such as gender-based asylum, Violence Against Women Act Petitions, T Visas (for survivors of human trafficking), U Visas (for survivors of certain crimes on U.S. soil), and Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (for abused, abandoned, or neglected children). Spanish speaking is preferred.

ELIGIBILITY: Any third-year female-identifying law student at one of the accredited Houstonarea law schools (*South Texas College of Law – Houston, Texas Southern University, Thurgood Marshall School of Law, and the University of Houston Law Center*) is eligible to apply. If selected, prior to receipt of the Fellowship, the selected applicant will need to have graduated from one of the accredited Houston-area law schools and successfully completed the bar examination with a minimum passing score and completed any other requirements to practice law in Texas prior to the Fellowship Start Date.

CRITERIA: Fellowships will be awarded to applicants who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership and philanthropic potential, a strong commitment to the profession, and/or the ability to overcome difficult obstacles. Involvement in programs that highlight advancement or support of women in the legal profession and in the community and participation in community outreach programs will also be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Emailed applications for either or both of the Scholarships and/or the Fellowships must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. CST** on **Friday, March 8, 2024**.

RECOGNITION DATE: April 11, 2024 at the annual Premier Women in Law Luncheon. All scholarship and fellowship recipients are expected to attend the luncheon as guests of honor.
